



Shuswap District Arts Council BLAIR BORDEN MEMORIAL AWARD

Blair Borden, founding member of the Shuswap District Arts Council, and a life-long learner of music and art, made a significant donation to the Arts Council's Endowment Fund so that interest earned could be granted to musicians who wished to further their education or experience in music.

In Blair's memory, the Arts Council offers an award of not less than \$500 to one or two musicians who demonstrate a willingness to continue the learning process.

Regulations

1. Ineligible candidates shall include Award recipients from previous years and students of junior secondary school age and younger.
2. A letter of recommendation from qualified authorities substantiating the applicant's ability must be submitted if the applicant is under the age of 19.
3. Upon submission of the applications, the Selection Committee may ask applicants for an interview or to present examples of their work.
4. The Selection Committee shall consist of no fewer than four (4) community artists representing different branches of the arts and appointed by the Board of Directors.
5. The Selection Committee shall submit its choice of successful applicant(s) to the Board of Directors for ratification.
6. The Award will be presented to the successful applicant(s) by June 30.
7. The Arts Council would appreciate receiving a letter of acknowledgment upon receipt of the Award.
